## — IUKL Mace —

The mace is the symbol of the university's governing authority and power as accorded in the university's constitution. The Convocation Ceremony begins with the entrance of the University Mace, carried by the University Marshal. The mace is carried before the Chancellor and Pro-Chancellor, in procession and rests on its stand in full view of the assembly during Convocation. It signifies that the proceedings have official sanction. It is three feet in length and five kilograms in weight. The Infrastructure University Kuala Lumpur mace is made of sterling silver and the head of the mace is highlighted in gold. Silver is chosen for its elegance and portrays modernity.

The crown of the mace signifying the academic bonnet represents the university's motto – For Knowledge, For Humanity. The head of the mace holds the university's logo in a prime position. The intertwined design of lines on the head signifies the integration of infrastructure knowledge in various fields of study.

The shaft is designed with vertical lines which symbolize the strengths of the university; versatility, integrity, innovativeness and professionalism. It also shows that the university is focused in providing quality education and advanced knowledge.





The logo for the first Infrastructure University in Malaysia; Infrastructure University Kuala Lumpur, is a dynamic image. The logo visualises an open book with pages signifying the various programmes and disciplines that are offered by the university. Viewed from an angle, the pages are constructed into a building that represents the niche of the university: Infrastructure.

The words 'Infrastructure' and 'University' are adjacent to the tower building and the open book respectively to signify our motto: **'For Knowledge, For Humanity'**. The pages also portray wings that soar upwards, an epitome of our belief in embracing transformation for continual improvement.

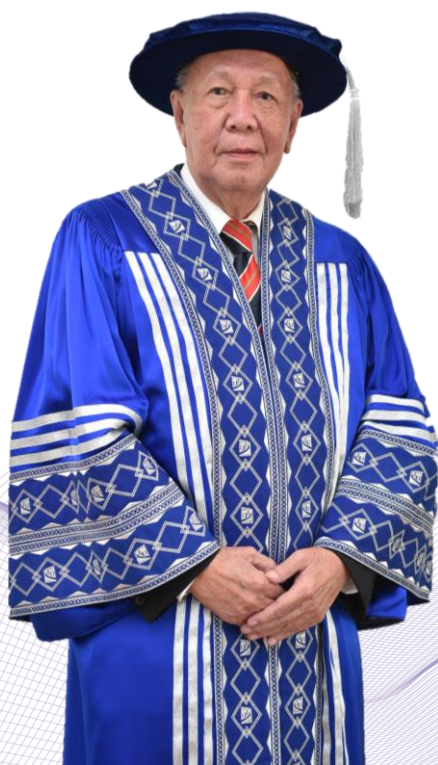

### BACHELOR

A Bachelor degree recipient will wear a navy-blue colour gown with bell-shaped sleeves (as shown). The recipient will wear black hood lined with silk according to the colour of the recipient's faculty. The headgear adorned by the graduand is a square black mortar board that comes with black tassel that is placed on the left side of the headgear during the convocation.

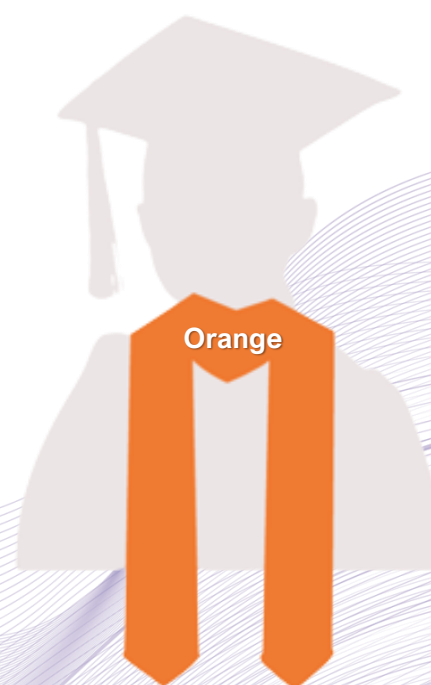

Professor Dr Faridah Ibrahim, is a Professor in Journalism and Communication at the Faculty of Business, Information and Human Sciences, IUKL. In her ten years at IUKL, she has served as the Executive Dean and Head of Postgraduate Programme for Communication, and currently serving as the Editor-in-Chief for IUKL flagship journal, *International Journal of Infrastructure Research and Management (IJIRM)*. She was previously with Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia for 28 years and was instrumental in positioning the prestigious *Jurnal Komunikasi-Malaysian Journal of Communication (JKMJC,UKM)* to a SCOPUS index journal.

She has a Bachelor Degree in Mass Communication from UiTM, Master in Journalism from University of Missouri-Columbia, USA, the First Journalism School in the World, and doctoral degree from the Universiti Putra Malaysia twinning with School of Journalism and Mass Communication, University of Minnesota-Twin Cities, USA.

In the area of academic supervision, she had led to completion a total of 25 PhD students and 52 master students and served as a PhD External Examiner to many local universities as well as Universiti Brunei Darussalam.

She was the former Chair for the Council of Heads of Communication Studies in Malaysia (COHECS), under MoHE, a member of Board of Directors with Malaysia National News Agency - BERNAMA, Film Development Board - FINAS and sub-committee Board in TV Al Hijrah, and was a member of MQA Jawatankuasa Mesyuarat Akreditasi (MJA) and she is currently a MQA panel, and Panel of Jury for MPI National Press Award, Malaysia. Her research areas and publications include Journalism and Communication, Peace and War journalism, Organizational Communication, Media Ethics, Film and Broadcasting, and Women in the Media. She has published over 200 books, book chapters and journals. She was a former journalist in a national newspaper daily, *Utusan Malaysia*.

Her philosophy in life is "What you are TODAY is a reflection of WHAT you have done YEARS ago." Reflecting on this helps her take ownership of her past, appreciate the present and look forward to the future.





## Best PhD Supervisor



Dr. Tadiwa Elisha Nyamasvisva was born in a remote town of Mutoko in Rural Zimbabwe. He is currently living in Malaysia with his wife Millie and two Kids Tyler Lucas (9) and Riley (3). Dr. Tadiwa is the first born of six siblings 5 Boys and a girl. Being the first child, he was the first but not last in the family to study in university. Graduating with a Diploma in Education (mathematics and statistics) from University of Zimbabwe in 1996, Dr. Tadiwa sought to advance his education in Computing in 2003. That landed him in Malaysia and at Ikram College of Technology (now IUKL) as the first international student. He pursued his Diploma in Information Technology and subsequently his Bachelor of Information Technology (Hons) in Network Technology, graduating in 2008 at KLIUC.

Dr. Tadiwa was the first in many things when he was a student in ICT and KLIUC - The first president of the International Students Association, the first International Students Bureau in KLIUC Students Representative Society. He was active in co-curricular activities and represented KLIUC in rugby, darts, tennis, indoor and outdoor rowing among other things. Dr. Tadiwa also participated in the program *Anak Angkat* with KLIUC in Kedah, Terengganu, and Kelantan.

His efforts at KLIUC earned him a full scholarship with University Technology PETRONAS (UTP) to further his postgraduate studies graduating with a master's degree (2011) and PhD (2016). For PhD, he was involved in PETRONAS' mega project involving 6 universities anchored by a RM43 million grant to design a Novel Antenna for shallow water deep oil target exploration. His contribution was designing a denoising algorithm for the seabed logging data obtained by the designed antenna. The algorithm is now wholly owned by PETRONAS CARIGALI.

Upon Graduation from UTP, Dr. Tadiwa rejoined IUKL in 2017 as a lecturer. He is currently the Dean of the Centre for Postgraduate Studies at IUKL. He is an Information Technology lecturer at the department of Computing, Faculty of Engineering, Science and Technology. He is also the advisor for the Nigerian Students Association, Bangladesh Students Association as well as the Somali Students Association.

He has been invited as a keynote speaker and guest speaker at local and international conferences and seminars. He has been as trainer for cyber security awareness for local and international audiences. Dr. Tadiwa had supervised to completion, 2 PhD IT candidates. One graduated on time (GOT), 8 Semesters, 7 Publications with minor corrections. He has supervised to completion 8 MIT candidates and many UG inal year projects. He is currently supervising 8 PhD candidates. He has published more than 40 journal papers to date with a combined readership of more than 23,000 on ResearchGate.

Dr. Tadiwa's wishes to establish an extension of IUKL in Zimbabwe as a branch or satellite campus.
